

Gibbons will be ordained deacon June 6 in Cathedral

SPRINGFIELD — Donald Patrick Gibbons will be ordained to the transitional diaconate by Bishop Daniel L. Ryan at 7 p.m. Thursday, June 6, in the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception.

The transitional diaconate is a step toward priesthood, which ordinarily occurs six months to a year later.

Gibbons will complete his theological studies this fall at Kenrick Seminary, St. Louis. He will be assigned to a parish this summer.

A 1973 graduate of Gillespie High School, Gibbons still considers St. Joseph Parish, Benld, as home after getting to see the world.

After high school he attended Southern Illinois University at Carbondale and then graduated with a bachelor's degree in fine arts (photography) from Illinois State University in 1977.

He joined the Navy and served for five years as a photographer, working for five admirals in places as far apart as Japan and Italy.




