## Sacraments of Initiation



### Baptism

We are freed from Original Sin and personal sin, become children of God, and are welcomed into the Church.



### Confirmation

Our faith is deepened & strengthened, so that it will be strong enough not only for our own needs but for the needs of others with whom we shall try to share it.



### Eucharist

We receive the Body and Blood of Christ in which Jesus is truly present under the appearances of bread and wine.
