

The O Antiphons refer to the seven antiphons that are recited (or chanted) preceding the Magnificat during Vespers of the Liturgy of the Hours.

They cover the special period of Advent preparation known as the Octave before Christmas, Dec. 17-23, with Dec. 24 being Christmas Eve and Vespers for that evening being for the Christmas Vigil.

Each antiphon highlights a title for the Messiah & refers to a prophecy of Isaiah of the coming of the Messiah.

Sapientia O Wisdom of our God Most High, DEC **WISDOM** guiding creation with power and love: 17 come to teach us the path of knowledge! Isaiah 11:2-3, 28:29 Adonaí O Leader of the House of Israel, DEC LORD OF ISRAEL giver of the Law to Moses on Sinai: 18 come to rescue us with your mighty power! Isaiah 11:4-5, 33:22 Radíx Jesse O Root of Jesse's stem, DEC **ROOT OF JESSE** sign of God's love for all his people: 19 come to save us without delay! Isaiah 11:1, 10 Clavis David O Key of David, DEC **KEY OF DAVID** opening the gates of God's eternal Kingdom: 20 come and free the prisoners of darkness! Isaiah 22:22, 9:6 Oriens O Radiant Dawn, DEC **RADIANT DAWN**, splendor of eternal light, sun of justice: DAYSPRING come and shine on those who dwell in DAYSPRING 21 darkness and in the shadow of death. Isaiah 9:2 Rex Gentium O King of all nations and DEC KING OF ALL NATIONS, keystone of the Church: KING OF THE GENTILES come and save man, 22 whom you formed from the dust! Isaiah 9:7, 2:4 Fmmanuel DEC O Emmanuel, our King and Giver of Law: GOD WITH US come to save us, Lord our God! 23Isaiah 7:14 EMMANUEL
