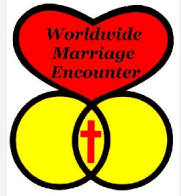
Tootsie Roll Drive. The annual Intellectual Disabilities drive will be held on Friday, Saturday, Sunday, October 4th-6th.

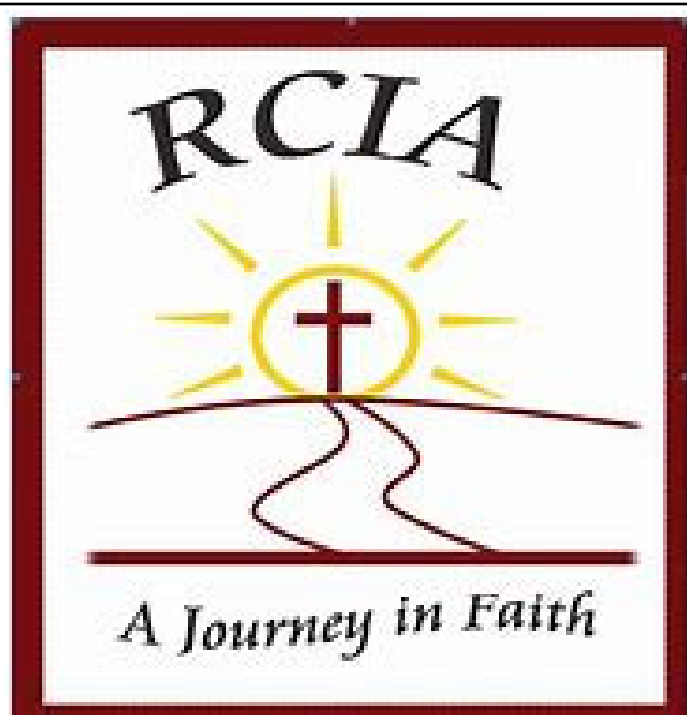
