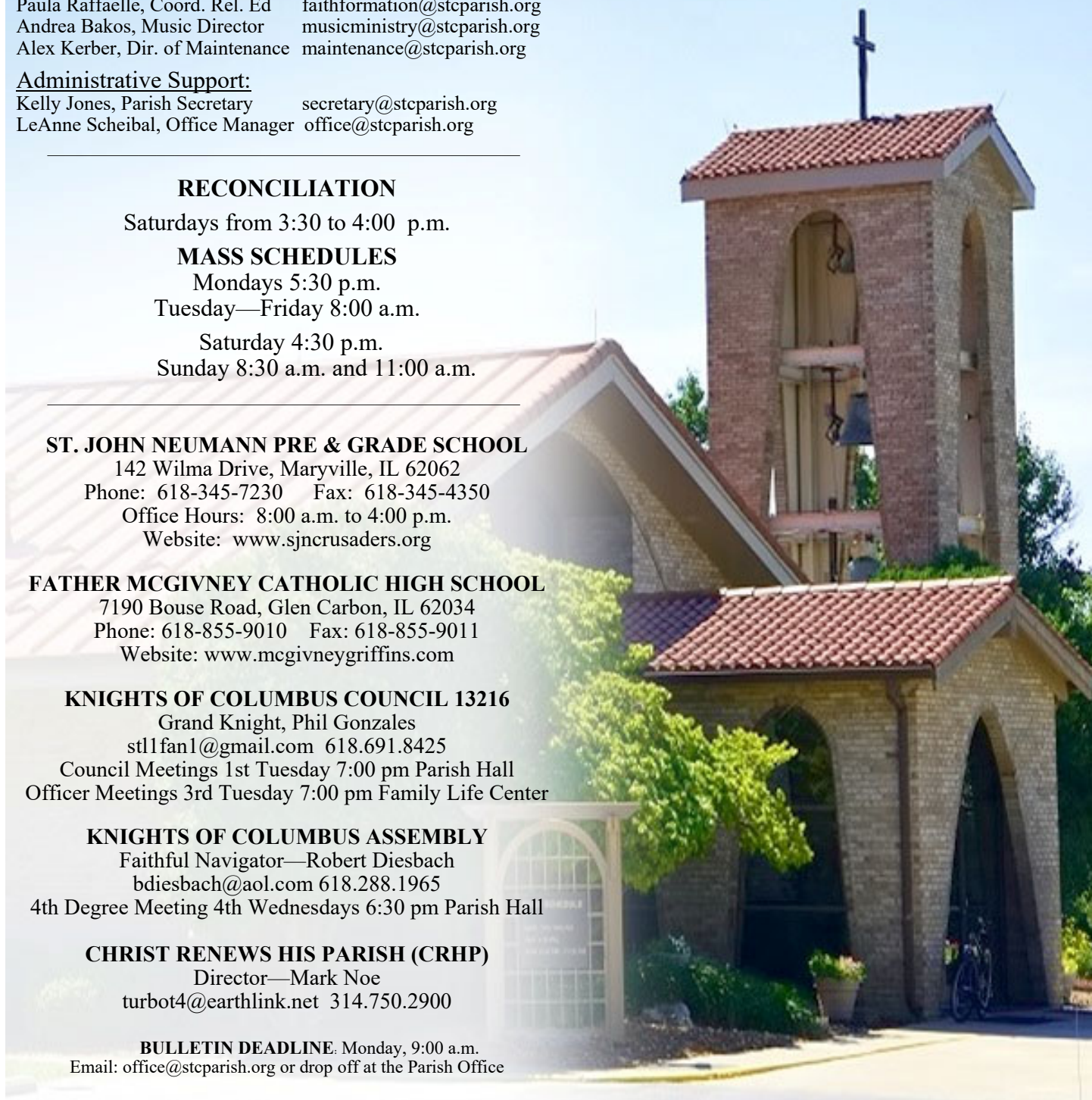

## Diocese of Springfield News ...

Dear Friends of Divine Mercy,

I would like to provide you with an update on the Divine Mercy Senior Living Community project. Please know that extensive work continues on a daily basis toward our goal of making Divine Mercy a reality. First off, I am pleased to report to you on success of your fundraising efforts in the Alton Deanery parishes. As you may recall, the collective campaign goal for the 22 deanery parishes was to raise \$5,000,000. To date, the parish campaigns have raised over \$5.4 million! We are incredibly grateful for the generosity of so many donors. We have recorded over 2100 pledges from our Catholic households in the Alton Deanery. This is incredible and truly demonstrates widespread support for the Divine Mercy project. We are also deeply indebted to our deanery pastors for their outstanding leadership and to the wonderful parish campaign volunteers for their unselfish, determined efforts and indefatigable spirit!

The success of your parish campaigns coupled with the generosity of several major gift donors have provided most of the fundraising dollars needed to help finance the project. There are several major gift requests that have been made and are pending and we remain confident we can achieve 100% of our overall fundraising goal. We are truly appreciative of Bishop Paprocki's dedicated and substantial efforts to secure major gifts for the campaign.

Planning and development work has continued to progress on the Divine Mercy project, but a couple of key developments have affected the timeline of the project:

1. Providentially, our new Diocesan Financial Officer has an extensive business background that includes development and management of commercial real estate. Through his insights, opportunities have been identified to refine the financing structure of the project and reduce risk. Some of these items, however, have caused us to rework parts of the plan that might have caused challenges for us down the road.
2. The construction and site development cost estimates have come in higher than forecasted in the original plan. A significant portion of these increased costs are related to the remediation of the soil conditions on the site. Strategies are being developed and work is being done to mitigate these increases and to control and reduce overall project costs.

The net result is that we are continuing working hard to improve the development plan for Divine Mercy in light of recent developments; but more time is needed to complete our due diligence. Consequently, our target for groundbreaking will be delayed until the Spring of 2020. This new timeline will help to ensure the success of Divine Mercy for the benefit of our deserving Catholic seniors.

Bishop Paprocki and the Diocesan Finance Council have been kept apprised of these developments and are fully supportive of the revised plans and timelines. Like any major development, we have experienced and likely will continue to experience new and unanticipated challenges, and we will continue to be good stewards of your investment in this project. We intend to honor the commitments of our donors, clergy and stakeholders by making Divine Mercy the best possible senior living community.

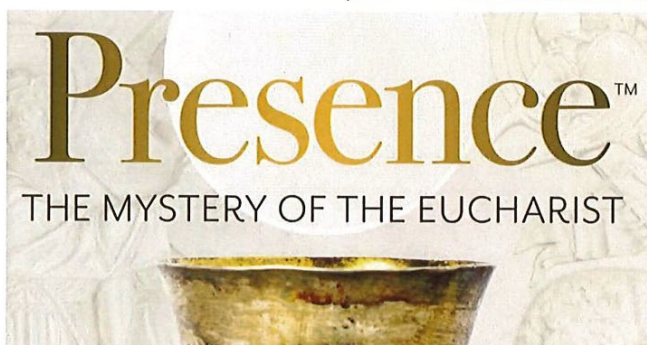

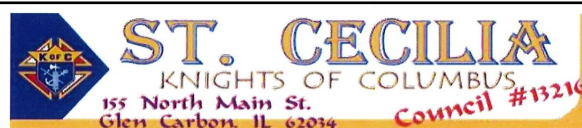
