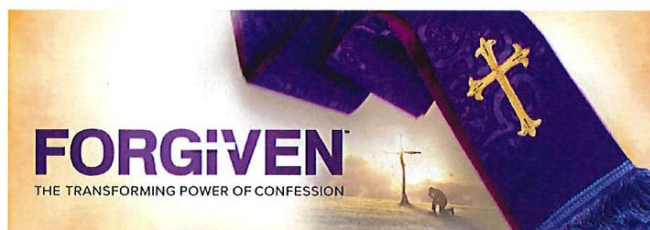

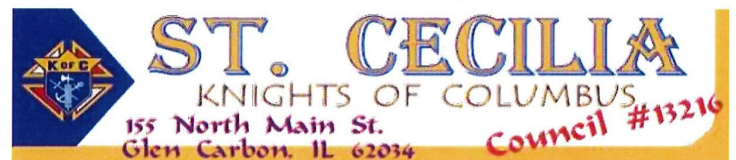

The retreat consists of:

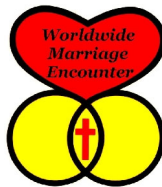
- **Daily Mass**

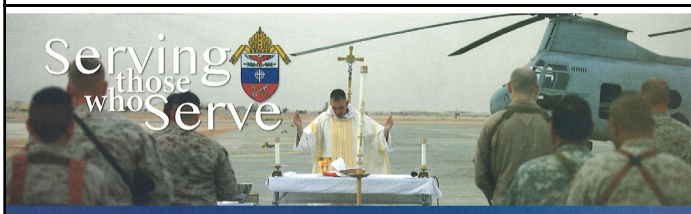

Established by Saint John Paul II in 1985, the AMS is the only US Diocese responsible for providing pastoral care to men and women serving in the US Armed Forces, enrolled at a US Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 US Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers, or working for the federal government beyond US borders. AMS priests and deacons serve approx. 1.8 million Catholics who hail from 50 states and US territories.
