### **NOTE ON ASH WEDNESDAY** **Distribution of Ashes in Time of Pandemic**

The Priest says the prayer for blessing the ashes. He sprinkles the ashes with holy water, without saying anything. **Then he addresses all those present and only once says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to ALL in general: "Repent, and believe in the Gospel," or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."**

The Priest then cleanses his hands, puts on a face mask and distributes the ashes to those who come to him or, if appropriate, he goes to those who are standing in their places. The Priest takes the ashes and sprinkles them on the head of each one without saying anything.

### **Lenten Regulations**

**ABSTINENCE**—Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

**FAST**—Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.

To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.

May this holy season be a time of spiritual renewal for each of us!

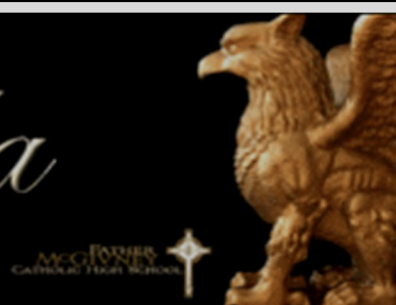

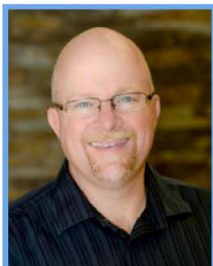

#### **PRAY & FAST**

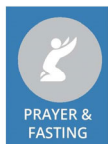

#### **PEACEFUL VIGIL**

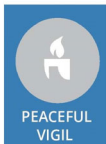
Pray for 1 hour at the abortion facility in Granite City.
