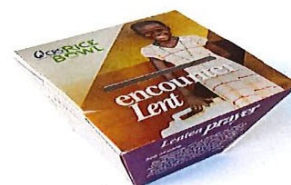

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Divine Mercy—Sunday, April 28, 2019

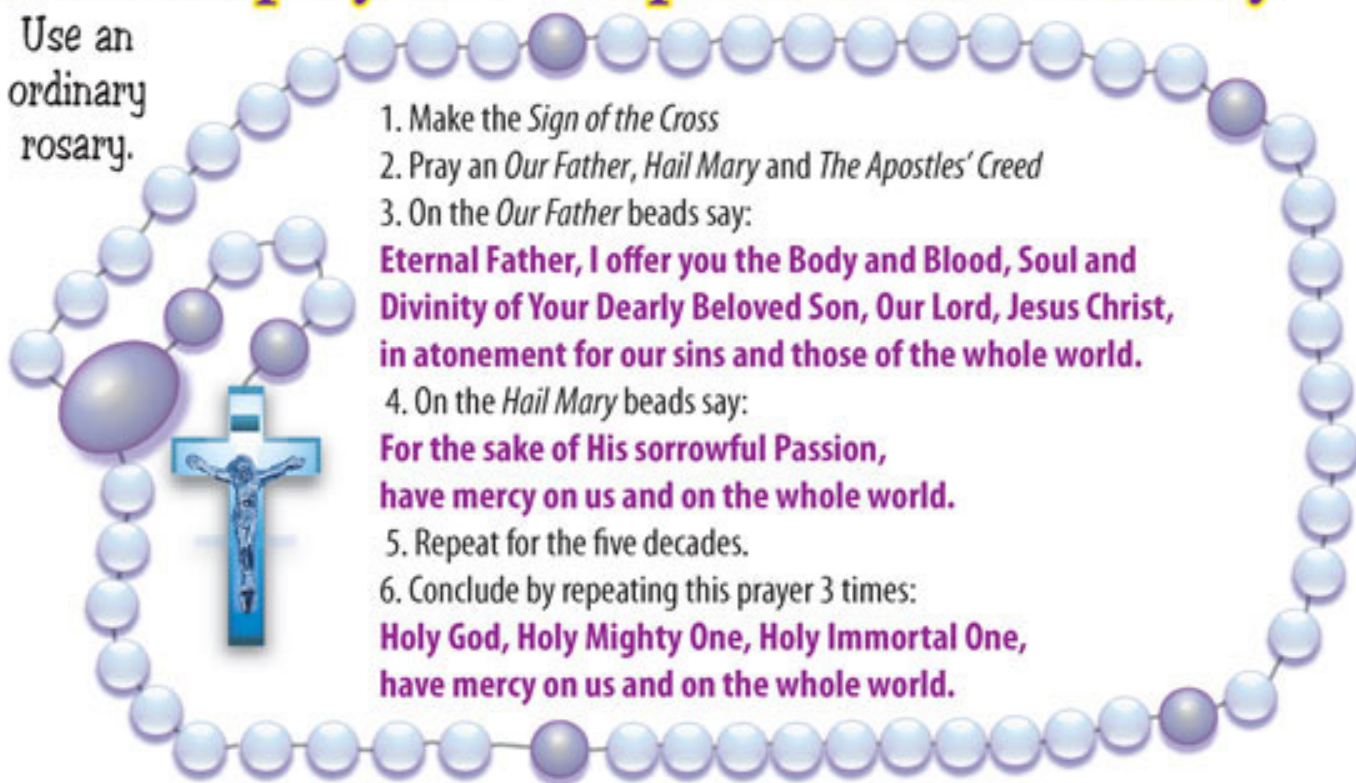
Saint Pope John Paul II established the Second Sunday of Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday. St. Elizabeth Church in Granite City will be having a Divine Mercy Novena and a Divine Mercy Service. All are invited to attend.

The Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday and continues every day through April 27th. You may say the novena on your own (pamphlets are available at St. Elizabeth to guide you in this daily prayer) or attend the prayer novena service at 3:00 pm each day at St. Elizabeth.

The closing service will be on April 28th (Divine Mercy Sunday) from 2:00-3:30 pm at St. Elizabeth. The blessing and veneration of the image will conclude with the Divine Mercy Chaplet and Benediction.

How to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

Use an ordinary rosary.



1. Make the *Sign of the Cross*

2. Pray an *Our Father*, *Hail Mary* and *The Apostles' Creed*

3. On the *Our Father* beads say:

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

4. On the *Hail Mary* beads say:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

5. Repeat for the five decades.

6. Conclude by repeating this prayer 3 times:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

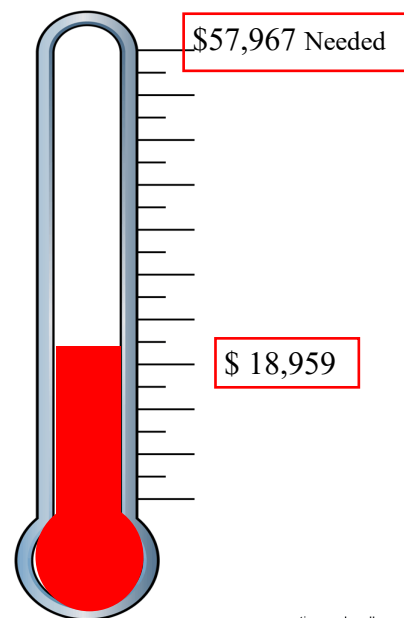
