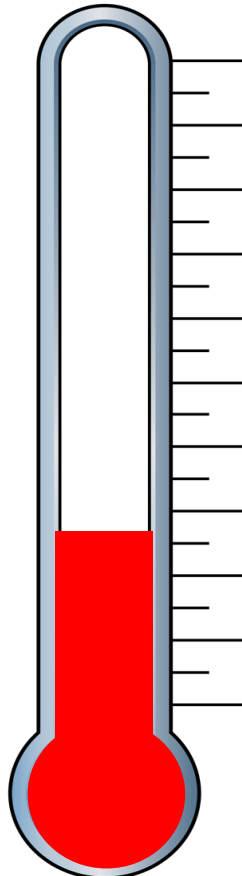

If you've never experienced Totus Tuus before, come discover for yourself; and if you've experienced it before, come back as we dive into a new theme for this summer—the Sacraments and the Sorrowful Mysteries. Please note that they usually need to be on the road by 6:30 to return to the parish for the evening program.
