## The Season of Stewardship

BUT AS IT IS, THERE ARE MANY PARTS,  
YET ONE BODY.  
1 COR 12:20

THIS WEEKEND WE HEAR FROM OUR PASTOR ON STEWARDSHIP AS A WAY OF LIFE. EACH OF US IS CALLED TO PRAYER, SERVICE, AND GIVING. HOW HAVE YOU PRIORITIZED YOUR LIFE TOWARD JESUS?

### A WEEK'S REFLECTION ON STEWARDSHIP

Below are Biblical passages on the meaning of Christian Stewardship. Throughout the week, read a daily passage and internalize its meaning for your life and the personal importance of fulfilling the need to give—giving the gifts of time, talent and treasure bestowed upon all of us through God's Grace and Love.

#### DAY ONE

**"All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."**

Matthew 28: 19-20

*How can I be a disciple of Jesus in my community?*

*How do I encourage others to be disciples of Jesus?*

#### Day Two

**"For as in one body we have many members, and not all the members have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members of one another. We have gifts that differ according to the grace given us: prophecy, in proportion to faith; ministry, in ministering; the teacher, in teaching; the exhorter, in exhortation; the giver, in generosity; the leader, in diligence; the compassionate, in cheerfulness."** Romans 12: 4-8





## SAVE THE DATE

Fr. Michael J. McGivney, the founder of the Knights of Columbus, and the priest for whom our school is named, will be beatified during a special mass **October 31** at the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Hartford.

You are invited to the **Father McGivney Catholic School beatification celebration**. Join Bishop Thomas John Paprocki for this momentous event. Due to COVID-19 restrictions we will be limiting congregation size and practicing social distancing. Facial coverings will be required.

On May 27, the Vatican announced that Pope Francis, who met with the board of directors of the Knights of Columbus in February, had signed the decree recognizing a miracle through the intercession of McGivney, clearing the way for his beatification. Once he is beatified, he will be given the title "Blessed."
