

Patching and minor repairs have taken place for

about a decade, but we must fix the root cause of the increasing leak problems in the Parish Hall as soon as possible to avoid more irreversible damage. Father, Alex, and the Buildings & Grounds Committee led by Steve Skasick have been investigating the problem, met with multiple contractors, spoken with the Diocese, and hired a contractor to begin work on this issue asap. The budget prior to meeting with contractors was \$10,000, but the project is significantly higher at about \$30,000. 
