





Faith formation is a life-long process. Join us as we learn about our faith.



Catholic Studies Certificate Program



We will be partnering with the University of Dayton and the Diocese of Springfield to offer new ways to further your education in Catholic Studies. As we begin our second year of class offerings we continue to expand, and our formats will enable more people to participate. Face to face or online, college students or anyone interested in continuing education in Catholic Studies. The courses will be taught by Robin Black-Rubenstein or Sean Barth, both Aquinas Institute of Theology graduates approved by the University of Dayton and the Diocese of Springfield to offer these courses.

Spring 2022 Classes

 Christology – January 17th- Feb 9 asynchronous with 1 hour face to face or zoom discussion each Thursday 5-6 pm at St. Mary's School Edwardsville II. Cost is \$40.

This understanding of Jesus Christ is the fruit of the study of person and mission of Jesus Christ: Christology. This has been a central focus of study for theology since the beginning of the Church. What we believe and argue today about whom Jesus is and what He did was earned through much prayer, thought and argument. This course will enable students to learn and understand the foundations upon which all Christology rests, the theology developed from the apostolic age through the Council of Chalcedon in the fifth century A.D. Successful completion of this course earns 2.5 CEU's. University of Dayton Certificate, 1.5 University of Dayton credits, or 10 CEU's for Diocese of Springfield Certificate Program

2. Survey of Catholic Social Doctrine- March 7th- April 9th This course will look at some of the major doctrines of the Catholic Church. Participants will come to a better understanding of the Trinity, original sin, church, salvation history, and the communion of saints. Participants will be asked to identify the meaning of magisterium, ecumenism, eschatology, and other Catholic terms.

Drainage Repairs Completed November 18, 2021

The drainage repairs were recently completed by Noeth Excavating correcting critical drainage issues causing foundation cracks and leaks in the Parish Hall. B-Dry Systems has now been contracted to complete the crack repairs in the Hall foundation.

Noeth will return in the Spring to complete the landscaping.

The repair costs were approximately \$30,000. Volunteers from CRHP, KC, and Father McGivney families saved the parish over \$4,000 removing landscaping and preparing the area prior to the work and moving rock back to the area following. A family has also donated \$10,000 towards this repair. If you'd like to make a donation, please let Father or LeAnne know.
