**Bishop Paprocki to Offer Mass at Tolton's Grave:** On July 9th, to commemorate the 125th anniversary of the death of the Venerable Servant of God, Augustine Tolton, Bishop Paprocki will lead a procession from St. Peter's Church to Father Tolton's grave in St. Peter Cemetery, where he will offer the Holy Mass. The procession will begin at 10 am and the Mass will begin at 11 am. Those unable to take part in the roughly one-mile-long procession route may park near the cemetery (but not in the cemetery, due to lack of space) for the Mass.
