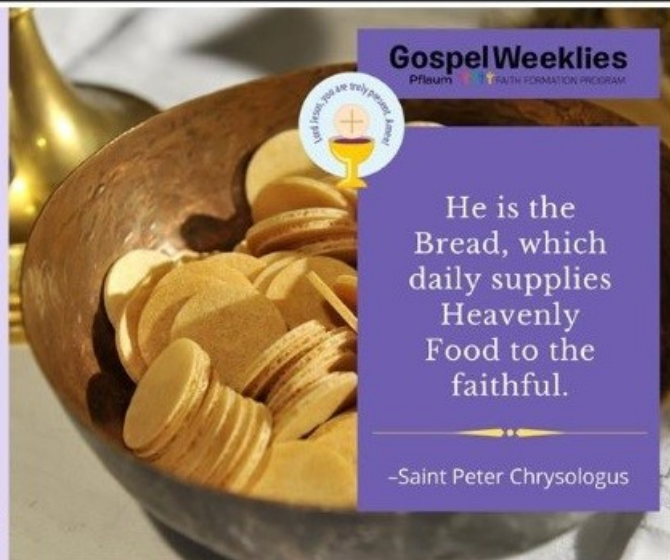

About Our Raffle
The raffle was developed to address some shortfalls in our overall operating budget's costs and to keep the cost of tuition reasonable. Affording a Catholic education should be attainable for everyone. This raffle will be one of 3 major fundraisers that we do each year. The fundraisers will be the School Auction, Apex Fun Run, and the Raffle. These fundraisers account for about 10% of the school's total budget (depending on the year), which helps to keep our tuition rate manageable for our families.

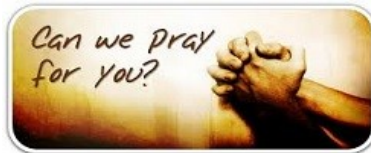
