Prayer Partner Fact Sheet

What should I wear/bring?

It is advised that prayer partners check the weather forecast and dress appropriately for the weather. Feel free to bring anything that you may need during your allotted vigil shift including water, umbrellas, sunglasses, sunscreen, chair, etc. Please **do not bring** signs; 40 Days for Life will provide you with signs.

Where do I park?

As shown on the map on the reverse side of this page, Hope Clinic for Women is located at 1602 21st Street in Granite City, IL (at the corner of Iowa Street and 21st Street). Prayer partners may park on any side street surrounding the abortion facility, but we recommend Iowa street (which is a one-way street heading south). Parking in the facility parking lot is prohibited. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your vigil hour to allow time to park.

What do I do when I get there?

Look for the 40 Days for Life sign (pictured to the right).
See the map on the reverse side of this page for our group's location.
Read the instructions in the binder in the resource box and then begin praying.

What do I do if someone asks me for help?

The resource box contains information about local Pregnancy Resource Centers. You are encouraged to share this information. Because we have not trained anyone at this time, please **do not** sidewalk counsel.

Who do I contact in the case of an emergency or question?

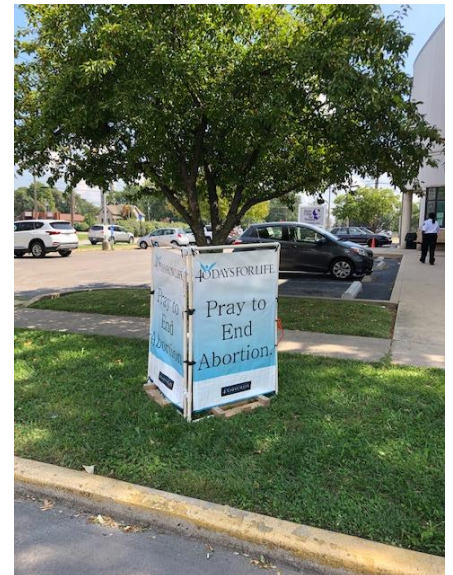
In case of an emergency, please call 911 or contact the 40 Days for Life Granite City Core Team at (636) 206-6220.

Prayer Partner Fact Sheet

The 40 Days for Life team would like to remind everyone that this is meant to be a **peaceful, prayerful witness united in Christian love**. Anyone acting in a violent or harmful manner immediately and completely disassociates themselves from the 40 Days for Life Campaign. With that in mind, please keep to the following **Code of Conduct**:

Safety First! – Please stand on sidewalk, or on grass between sidewalk and street. This is public property and we are legally allowed to stand in this area. Do **not** stand in the grass between the sidewalk and the facility’s parking lot. We are not allowed on facility property at any time. You may walk along the sidewalk, but do not stand in the street, obstruct the facility entrance, or block people walking on the sidewalk.

Respect the Law – 40 Days for Life is designed to work within the law; it is not the place for civil disobedience or violence. Any misconduct from passersby should be met with silence. Please show love and compassion toward abortion facility workers, volunteers, and customers.

Sign Usage – Please only use the signs provided to you by the 40 Days for Life team.

Resource Box - Never leave signs or box unattended on sidewalk!

No Political Activity – While much needs to be done to change the anti-life laws in this country, this is meant to be a campaign to change hearts.

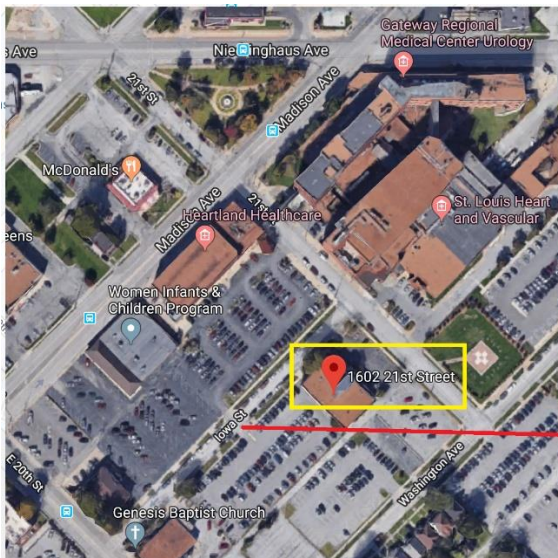
Children are Welcome – Keep children close and encourage them to pray or play quietly and safely.

Food – Please refrain from eating during your shift unless medical necessity requires it. Only small children should be eating during the vigil.

Prayerful Witness – Pray however you like, all we ask is that you remain in prayer for the entirety of your shift.

Where to Park

On Iowa Street

WHERE TO STAND

- Stand on the Iowa Street side of the clinic.
- Stand on the sidewalk or in the grass between the sidewalk and Iowa Street.
- Stand between the clinic parking lot entrance (do not block) and the clinic sidewalk entrance.

PARKING

Park on Iowa Street. Iowa Street is one-way street heading south

Where to Stand

Iowa Street side—see star below
