- 6. Practical guide to receive the Eucharist.
 - a. Practice last month before 1st Communion.
 - b. Practice both receiving on hand and on tongue.
 - c. Receiving Body of Christ on hand:
 - i. hands nicely folded when walking
 - ii. small bow, when person in front is receiving
 - iii. immediately after bow, make a throne for Jesus
 - 1. dominant hand on bottom
 - 2. push hands out to direct presider to place Eucharist in hand
 - iv. say "Amen"
 - v. step to the side
 - 1. Receive the Eucharist
 - 2. Make the Sign of the Cross
 - d. Receiving Body of Christ on tongue:
 - i. hands nicely folded when walking
 - ii. small bow, when person in front is receiving
 - iii. lift head
 - iv. say "Amen"
 - v. stick out tongue
 - vi. step to the side
 - 1. Make the Sign of the Cross
 - e. Receiving **Blood** of Christ:
 - i. small bow, when person in front is receiving
 - ii. take chalice with 2 hands:
 - 1. on stem
 - 2. on bottom
 - iii. take a small drink
 - iv. hand chalice back
 - v. Make the Sign of the Cross
