

Reconciliation


1 EXAMINE your conscience in a quiet place before receiving this sacrament.



- **2 ENTER** the confessional and **LISTEN** to the priest's greeting.
- 3 MAKE the sign of the cross and say:







I am sorry for these and all my sins.



- 6 LISTEN as the priest assigns your PENANCE.
- **7 PRAY** the Act of Contrition prayer (out loud):

O my God.

I am heartily sorry for having offended You and I detest all my sins,

because I dread the loss of heaven and the pains of Hell, but most of all because they offend you, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love.

I firmly resolve, with the help of your grace, to confess my sins,

to do penance

and to amend my life. Amen.

8 LISTEN as the priest places his hand over your head and gives you ABSOLUTION.

God the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of His Son has reconciled the world to Himself and poured out the Holy Spirit for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God grant you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

MAKE the sign of the cross when the priest absolves you.

9 PRAISE the mercy of God by responding after the priest:

PRIEST: Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good.

His mercy endures forever.

10 RETURN to your pew and DO your penance.
