Athanasian Creed

Whoever wishes to be saved must, above all, keep the Catholic faith.

For unless a person keeps this faith whole & entire, he will undoubtedly be lost forever.

Trinity	<p>This is what the Catholic faith teaches: we worship 1 God in the Trinity & the Trinity in unity. Neither confounding the Persons, nor dividing the substance.</p>
	<p>For there is 1 person of the Father, another of the Son, another of the Holy Spirit. But the Father & the Son & the Holy Spirit have 1 divinity, equal glory, & coeternal majesty. What the Father is, the Son is, & the Holy Spirit is. The Father is uncreated, the Son is uncreated, & the Holy Spirit is uncreated. The Father is boundless, the Son is boundless, & the Holy Spirit is boundless. The Father is eternal, the Son is eternal, & the Holy Spirit is eternal.</p>
	<p>Nevertheless, there are NOT 3 eternal beings, but 1 eternal being.</p>
	<p>So there are NOT 3 uncreated beings, nor 3 boundless beings, but 1 uncreated being & 1 boundless being. Likewise, the Father is omnipotent, the Son is omnipotent, the Holy Spirit is omnipotent. Yet there are NOT 3 omnipotent beings, but 1 omnipotent being. Thus the Father is God, the Son is God, & the Holy Spirit is God. However, there are NOT 3 gods, but 1 God. The Father is Lord, the Son is Lord, & the Holy Spirit is Lord. However, there are NOT 3 lords, but 1 Lord. For as we are obliged by Christian truth to acknowledge every Person singly to be God & Lord, so too are we forbidden by the Catholic religion to say that there are 3 Gods or Lords. The Father was NOT made, nor created, nor generated by anyone. The Son is NOT made, nor created, but begotten by the Father alone. The Holy Spirit is NOT made, nor created, nor generated, but proceeds from the Father & the Son.</p>
3 Persons	<p>There is, then, 1 Father, NOT 3 Fathers; 1 Son, NOT 3 sons; 1 Holy Spirit, NOT 3 holy spirits.</p>
	<p>In this Trinity, there is NOTHING before or after, NOTHING greater or less. The entire 3 Persons are coeternal & coequal with 1 another. So that in all things, as is has been said above, the Unity is to be worshipped in Trinity & the Trinity in Unity. He, therefore, who wishes to be saved, must believe thus about the Trinity.</p>
Incarnation	<p>It is also necessary for eternal salvation that he believes steadfastly in the incarnation of our Lord Jesus Christ. Thus the right faith is that we believe & confess that our Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is both God & man.</p>
	<p>As God, He was begotten of the substance of the Father before time; as man, He was born in time of the substance of His Mother. He is perfect God; & He is perfect man, with a rational soul & human flesh. He is equal to the Father in His divinity, but inferior to the Father in His humanity. Although He is God & man, He is NOT 2, but 1 Christ. And He is 1, NOT because His divinity was changed into flesh, but because His humanity was assumed unto God. He is 1, NOT by a mingling of substances, but by unity of person. As a rational soul & flesh are 1 man: so God & man are 1 Christ. He died for our salvation, descended into hell, & rose from the dead on the third day. He ascended into heaven, sits at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there He shall come to judge the living & the dead.</p>
	<p>At His coming, all men are to arise with their own bodies; & they are to give an account of their own deeds.</p>
	<p>Those who have done good deeds will go into eternal life; those who have done evil will go into the everlasting fire.</p>
	<p>This is the Catholic faith. Everyone must believe it, firmly & steadfastly, otherwise He cannot be saved. Amen.</p>
