

## Session 2 - The Last Supper

"Take, eat; this is my body.' And he took a chalice ... saying, 'Drink of it, all of you; for this is my blood of the covenant.'"

_____	<b>Mass</b>	<b>A</b>	A sacred relationship with God that makes us part of God's family.
_____	<b>Instituted</b>	<b>B</b>	The Liturgy in which we celebrate the Sacrament of the Eucharist.
_____	<b>Memorial</b>	<b>C</b>	The reality that Jesus is truly present, Body, Blood, Soul, & Divinity, in the Eucharist.
_____	<b>Paschal Mystery</b>	<b>D</b>	Jesus instituted the Sacraments of the Eucharist and Holy Orders (the priesthood) at this event.
_____	<b>Covenant</b>	<b>E</b>	Where Jesus performed his first public miracle - changing water into wine.
_____	<b>Transubstantiation</b>	<b>F</b>	Christ's work of redemption made possible by his Passion (suffering), Death, Resurrection, & Ascension into Heaven.
_____	<b>Real Presence</b>	<b>G</b>	This gives us food for our souls and fills us with grace.
_____	<b>Words of Consecration</b>	<b>H</b>	What Jesus & the Apostles were celebrating at the Last Supper.
_____	<b>Eucharist</b>	<b>I</b>	A celebration that helps us remember an important past event.
_____	<b>Last Supper</b>	<b>J</b>	The words of Jesus that the priest repeats at Mass – "This is my body," and "This is the chalice of my blood."
_____	<b>Wedding at Cana</b>	<b>K</b>	The change of bread & wine into the Body & Blood of Christ.
_____	<b>Passover</b>	<b>L</b>	To start or create something that is going to continue.
