Mass	Α	A sacred relationship with God that makes us part of God's family.
Instituted	В	The Liturgy in which we celebrate the Sacrament of the Eucharist.
Memorial	С	The reality that Jesus is truly present, Body, Blood, Soul, & Divinity, in the Eucharist.
Paschal Mystery	D	Jesus instituted the Sacraments of the Eucharist and Holy Orders (the priesthood) at this event.
Covenant	E	Where Jesus performed his first public miracle - changing water into wine.
Transubstantiation	F	Christ's work of redemption made possible by his Passion (suffering), Death, Resurrection, & Ascension into Heaven.
Real Presence	G	This gives us food for our souls and fills us with grace.
Words of Consecration	н	What Jesus & the Apostles were celebrating at the Last Supper.
Eucharist	ı	A celebration that helps us remember an important past event.
Last Supper	J	The words of Jesus that the priest repeats at Mass – "This is my body," and "This is the chalice of my blood."
Wedding at Cana	K	The change of bread & wine into the Body & Blood of Christ.
Passover	L	To start or create something that is going to continue.
