| Resurrection | D | The 3rd Person of the Blessed Trinity. |
| Ascension | E | God's gift to help us in each moment to love God and make the right choices. |
| Pentecost | F | Jesus - because of his great love for us, he offered himself to God as a sacrifice on the Cross & he gives himself to us as spiritual food in the Eucharist |
| Body of Christ | G | The gift of God's own diving life in us that makes us holy. |
| Witnesses | Н | For the Jewish people, it was the 7th day of the week, or Saturday. It was the day of worship for the Jewish people. |
| <u>Chrism</u> | I | Jesus' rising from the dead on the 3rd day after his Death on the Cross. |
| Sanctifying Grace | J | To put to death by nailing or tying a person to a cross as a form of punishment. |
| Actual Grace | K | The blessed oil used for anointing in Baptism & Confirmation. |
| Lamb of God | L | The forgiveness of our sins and healing of our friendship with God so that we can be with him in Heaven. |
| Holy Spirit | M | The descent of the Holy Spirit upon Mary & the Apostles. |
