Miracle	Α	The small wafer or piece of unleavened bread that becomes the Body of Christ.
Heaven	В	Another name for the Sacrament of the Eucharist because it unites us with Jesus.
Bread of Life Discourse	С	An ornate, boxlike container where the Eucharist is reserved for prayer & adoration outside of Mass.
Host	D	A sign or wonder that can only be worked by God.
Tabernacle	E	The Passover meal that Jesus shared with his Apostles on the night before his Crucifixion.
Genuflect	F	The sacrament instituted by Christ at the Last Supper, in which bread & wine are changed into his Body & Blood.
Venial Sins	G	A prayer in which we tell Jesus how much we want to be united with him.
Act of Spiritual Communion	н	Another name for the Eucharist, because it is the center of the sacramental life of the Church.
Eucharist	I	To bend the right knee to the floor or ground to show love & respect to Christ in the Tabernacle.
Lord's Supper	J	In the Liturgy of the Mass, the sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross is made present to us.
Holy Sacrifice	К	Jesus' teaching on the Eucharist in the Gospel of John, chapter 6.
The Most Blessed Sacrament	L	Lesser sins that do not result in a complete separation from God.
Holy Communion	Μ	The place where God dwells along with the angels & saints.
