_____	State of Grace	A	To show respect, especially for things that are holy.
_____	Mortal Sin	B	The small wafer or piece of unleavened bread that becomes the Body of Christ.
_____	Reverence	C	The bread & wine that has been changed into the Body & Blood of Jesus.
_____	Eucharistic Fast	D	The special act of worshipping Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.
_____	Consecrated	E	The special vessel used to display the Blessed Sacrament for Adoration.
_____	Monstrance	F	The state of having God's divine life of grace within us.
_____	Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament	G	The rule that we must not eat or drink anything for at least 1 hour before receiving Holy Communion.
_____	Host	H	A serious sin that separates us from God.
