Presentation of the Gifts	Α	The center & High point of the Liturgy of the Eucharist.
Preparation of the Altar	В	The song we all sing in union with the hosts of Heaven: "Holy, holy,"
Prayer over the Offerings	С	"This is my Body, which will be given up for you," & "this is the chalice of my Blood"
The Eucharistic Prayer	D	The prayer that the priest says over the bread & wine after they have been placed on the altar.
Preface	E	The priest or deacon gets the altar ready by placing all the necessary items in their places.
Sanctus	F	When the priest extends his hands over the bread & wine and asks the Holy Spirit to come down so that they may become the Body & blood of Christ.
Epiclesis	G	In this prayer we remember the Passion, Death, & Resurrection of Jesus & express our faith that he will come again.
Institution Narrative	Н	The bread & wine are brought up to the priest.
Words of Consecration	ı	The 1st part of the Eucharistic Prayer, where the priest gives thanks & glory to God.
Mystery of Faith or Memorial Acclamation	J	The part of the Eucharistic Prayer that tells the story of the Last Supper.

Chalice	Α	The special plate that holds the Host.
Paten	В	We pray the Lord's Prayer together.
Doxology	С	The special cup that holds the wine that will become the Blood of Christ.
Great Amen	D	The time when we receive the Body & blood of our Lord under the appearance of bread & wine.
The communion Rite	E	The priest gives us a final blessing, & we make the sign of the Cross. Then the priest or deacon announces that the Mass has ended.
Lamb of God	F	The prayer of praise giving glory to God at the end of the Eucharistic Prayer, which the priest prays while elevating the host & chalice.
Holy Communion	G	The priest acts "in the Person of Jesus the Head," as the representative of Jesus.
Prayer after Communion	н	The prayer we say or sing together which begins: "Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us"
Concluding Rite	ı	The prayer the priest says after we have all received Holy Communion.
In Persona Christi Capitis	J	The "Amen" that the whole congregation says or sings in response to the Doxology.
