Key Points

- Pentecost is when Jesus sent the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles.
 - This was the beginning of the mission of the church.
- The Holy Spirit is the third divine Person of the Holy Trinity.
 - He is the love between the Father and the Son.
- The Holy Spirit comes to dwell in our hearts at Baptism.
- Water, fire, a dove, and wind are symbols of the Holy Spirit.
- The Holy Spirit guides the Church, especially the Magisterium, the teaching office of the church.
















You are Sent - Session 2 - The Gifts & Fruits of the Holy Spirit

Key Points

- Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit as our Helper, Advocate, and Counselor.
- The Holy Spirit gives us his Seven Gifts in Baptism and strengthens them in Confirmation:
 - wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord.
- The Holy Spirit gives different charisms to each baptized person for the good of the whole church.
- Knowing & using the Gifts of the Holy Spirit produce the Fruits of the Holy Spirit in our lives:
 - love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.

You are Sent - Session 3 - The Sacrament of Confirmation

Key Points

- Confirmation perfects Baptism.
- The effects of confirmation on our souls and in our lives include ...
 - Strengthens our identity as children of God.
 - Unites us more closely to Jesus and strengthens us to be more like him
 - Increases the 7 Gifts of the Holy Spirit in us to help us be holy followers of Jesus.
 - Unites us more closely to God's family, the Church.
 - Gives us the power of the Holy Spirit to go out & be witnesses to Jesus through our words & actions just like the Apostles at Pentecost.
- We choose a Confirmation ...
 - **sponsor** to witness the Christian life to us and help us live that life.
 - saint to be an ex. of virtue & the Gifts & Fruits of the Holy Spirit, to always be close to & pray for us.

You are Sent - Session 4 - Receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation

Key Points

- Jesus breathed the Holy Spirit on his Apostles on Easter Sunday.
- In Confirmation we receive the same Spirit of peace that Jesus gave to His Apostles.
- The actions, materials, and words that make up the Rite of Confirmation are signs that reveal to us the grace that is given in the sacrament.
- The laying on of hands is a sign of calling down the Holy Spirit & his 7 Gifts on a person.

• The anointing with Sacred Chrism is a sign of the permanent seal of the Holy Spirit and his presence and power in our souls.

You are Sent - Session 5 - Sent on a Mission


Key Points

- We share God's love by serving others through the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy.
- The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life.
